TEAM® Essentials

Available in two-hour, instructor-led and 70 minute, e-Learning formats, this course teaches staff to recognize factors, hazards and situations that can escalate to aggression and violence. Participants complete the training knowing how to manage disruptive behavior and keep themselves and others safe.

TEAM® Advanced

This two-hour, instructor-led course teaches health care-specific strategies and skills designed to protect staff and patients from physical attack. Instructors use hands-on exercises and simulations to build the confidence needed to use the course's techniques in real life.

TEAM® Instructor

We cover the requirements to maintain the certification over the next two years, legal restrictions for using the program, adult learning theories, exercises on the type of learner/ instructor you are, and how to manage a classroom.
