- Non-clinical staff, such as environmental services workers and patient access representatives are available in many markets.
- Client facilities should consider onboarding cohorts of 5 to 10 contract staff at the same time to streamline onboarding and orientation. Larger cohorts are available.
- Assignments can range from 3 to 13 weeks and workers can respond to ASAP start dates with modified compliance requirements (attached). Facilities are encouraged to guarantee a 48-hour work week to maximize staff capacity.
- Pricing is set at the job level and will depend on positions needed, response time and requirements. Aya's crisis response leaders can advise on pricing for your specific needs.

- Aya has joined forces with <u>eight</u> of the largest nurse staffing companies as well as clinical and non-clinical emergency service organizations to mobilize additional healthcare workers in response to this situation.

- **48 Hours**: 48 Hr. Guarantees Are Highly Recommended to maximize staff (OT is billed After 48). Can also accommodate 36 Hr. Guarantees. All travelers will be on weekly guarantees (36 or 48 hr.'s), however. their assignment can be cancelled at any time. No fee or penalty, but a hospital must pay out full week's pay if you need to end an assignment early i.e. if a traveler works Monday and the assignment is cancelled, the facility is liable to paying the remainder of that week's guarantee pay.
- Auto-Offers: Aya has team of over 25 clinicians, each with over 15 years of experience who will be conducting Aya Auto-Offers. Their Clinical Team will call and verify job descriptions with your Managers to ensure we have a detailed description for each position.
